The course includes teaching methods, up-to-date sexual health information and practical demonstrations of classroom activities.

Participants will explore a range of resources and curriculum outlines, all mapped to the Australian Curriculum and the Department for Education's Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum.

The course is tailored to school staff working with secondary years students including teachers and SSOs. However, this course has no pre-requisite and is open to all interested.
