

IUD Insertion Training

An interactive course for doctors addressing the skills necessary for successful IUD insertion, assessment and management.

The training consists of an online learning module, a practical workshop with experienced medical practitioners and clinical training sessions.

It is designed for medical practitioners who are experienced in contraceptive consultations and cervical screening. Doctors with a minimum of two years of postgraduate experience in community based general practice or obstetrics and gynaecology in Australia and current registration with AHPRA as a medical practitioner can register for this training.

Clinical training sessions are available on successful completion of the theory component (online learning module and workshop). Sessions must be commenced within 3 months of completing the theory component.
