

Pregnancy Choices Training

This 1-day course will explore how to provide support and information through a greater understanding of pregnancy choices.

This course covers the broad social and political issues as well as clinical options, incorporating cultural considerations into topics and resources.

Participants will:

- discuss the social and political context of pregnancy
- consider the cultural implications of pregnancy inclusive of an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and Culturally and Linguistically Diverse perspective
- learn about family and domestic violence and reproductive coercion in the context of pregnancy
- develop further knowledge on contraception options including emergency contraception
- explore a broader understanding of abortion, pregnancy pathways, perinatal mental health and counselling responses to pregnancy

Eligibility

The course is open to nurses, midwives, doctors, counsellors, community health workers, school counsellors, youth workers, Aboriginal Health Workers and any professional who may work with clients who are pregnant.
