

# Teaching It Like It Is – Inclusive Education Relationships & Sexual Health Education for Students Living with a Disability

Learn how to teach a comprehensive relationships and sexual health program in a safe and inclusive environment.

Our 2-day course, facilitated by experienced educators, explores the information, skills and strategies staff needed to deliver a comprehensive relationships and sexual health program to students living with a disability. This course explores modified programs and resources to individualise content and make relationships and sexual health education accessible to children and young people living with a disability.

The course covers a range of resources and curriculum materials, all mapped to the Australian Curriculum and the Department for Education's Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum.

The course is tailored to all school staff working with students living with a disability including teachers and SSOs. Participants will receive resources and a Certificate of Attendance that references the relevant Australian Professional Standards for Teachers.
