

Teaching It Like It Is — Inclusive Education

Relationships & Sexual Health Education for Students Living with a Disability

Learn how to engage young people in comprehensive relationships and sexual health education in a safe and inclusive environment.

Our 2-day course, facilitated by experienced educators, explores the information, skills and strategies staff needed by adults to deliver comprehensive relationships and sexual health education to students living with a disability. This course explores modified programs and resources to individualise content and make relationships and sexual health education accessible to children and young people living with a disability.

The course covers a range of resources and curriculum materials, mapped to the Australian Curriculum and the Department for Education's Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum.

This course is open to any adults working with school-based students living with a disability including teachers, SSOs, Occupational Therapists, Psychologists and Developmental Educators. Participants will receive resources and a Certificate of Attendance that references the relevant Australian Professional Standards for Teachers.
