Our Primary course (covering Years 3-6) will help you develop the skills and confidence needed to teach relationships and sexual health education to primary years.

This 2-day course, facilitated by experienced educators, explores what makes a comprehensive relationships and sexual health program for primary years. Participants will develop facilitation skills and strategies for discussing sensitive issues. The course includes teaching methods, up-to-date sexual health information and practical demonstrations of classroom activities.

The course covers a range of resources and curriculum outlines, all mapped to the Australian Curriculum and the Department for Education's Keeping Safe: Child Protection Curriculum.

This course is tailored to school staff working with primary years students including teachers and SSOs.

Participants will receive resources and a Certificate of Attendance that references the relevant Australian Professional Standards for Teachers.
