Course outline

The Sexual and Reproductive Health Australia National Certificate for Doctors is awarded on successful completion of both the theoretical and clinical modules.

The theoretical component of this course covers the latest in clinical research, interactive case discussions, reflective learning and more.

Topics covered in the theory component include: Contraception, Breast health, Common gynaecological problems, Menopause, Sexually transmitted infections including PEP/PrEP, Cervical screening guidelines, Fertility and subfertility, Sexual violence, Andrology and urology, Pregnancy options and abortion services, Pelvic pain, Vulval dermatology, Sexual dysfunction, Sexual and reproductive health within Aboriginal communities and Prolapse and incontinence.

Clinical training sessions

Clinical training sessions take place after completion of the 5-day theory course. The sessions are direct hands-on training at SHINE SA clinics, with support from senior SHINE SA clinicians.
